To maintain this all staff participate in daily cleaning including sweeping, mopping, dusting, scrubbing crates and kennels, laundry, dishes, taking out the trash, and general cleaning/organization of all areas. The job is approximately 40% playing with the dogs 60% cleaning. Are you willing to help maintain our facilities in addition to working with the dogs?
