Camper Packing Instructions

WHAT TO PACK FOR CAMP

FOOD: Camp Bark strives to make your campers experience totally positive. In order to not upset anyone's stomach or digestive tract, we keep each camper on the same feeding schedule as home. **Please bring your dog's food labeled with his/her name (first and last!) and in individual daily baggies or a gallon Ziploc®.** If food is not properly bagged, a \$10 fee for storage will be charged. Please be sure and label any and all containers that you would like returned. WE DO NOT need your dog's bowls from home. We supply all dog bowls. We are happy to accommodate special diets and homeopathic menus (you must provide all food).

TREATS: There is no need to pack treats. Yet, you are welcome to send treats to camp for your camper. Please label all treats with your dog's name (first and last). We provide treats at bedtime and nap time. Please only pack treats that are soft and easy to chew. Based upon veterinarian recommendations we no longer give rawhides to dogs in our care, because they pose a safety concern (i.e.: non-digestible, blockages, and choking hazard). If your dog is not supposed to have treats, due to diet or medical restrictions, please let a camp counselor know so that your dog's records are properly noted.



MEDICATIONS AND SUPPLEMENTS:

All medications and supplements must be in original container with dosage clearly marked.

PLEASE NOTE: If your dog has fleas prior to camp, they will be treated at owners expense.

LEASH & COLLARS: All dogs arriving at Camp Bark must have a collar with ID tags. We do not need your dog's leash. Choke collars are prohibited unless your dog is participating in training classes. If that is the case, please label each collar with your dog's name.

BEDDING: Please leave your dog's bedding and/or favorite blanket at home. We want your dog to feel totally comfortable, so we will provide cots with cozy blankets, so that your pet can nap and sleep comfortably.

TOYS: Camp Bark has plenty of toys and balls that we can provide to our campers in a supervised environment. Please leave all toys at home so that your camper's toys are not destroyed by other campers!

Rates

**CAMP BARK DOES NOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS, CASH OR CHECK ONLY.
PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE TIME OF CHECK OUT.**

*Discounts for active firefighters, active police and active military personnel are available. Personnel will receive \$5.00 off per day on overnight visits.
This discount does not apply to day camp.

Any breed over 80 pounds will be charged an additional \$5/day on overnight visits

Overnight camp: 1 dog \$46 each day
 2 dogs or more (in the same household)
 20% discount on additional dogs after full price for the first dog
 Dogs over 80 lbs \$51 each day

** Camp Bark charges a daily rate versus a nightly rate, like a hotel. For overnight camp you are charged the full daily rate the day your dog checks in, regardless of what time. However, you will only be charged for the previous night if your dog check outs by 11:00AM (Monday – Saturday) on their pick up day. If you check out after 11 AM (4-6 pm pick-up time) you will be charged for that night as well. Any camper requiring check out during closed office hours will be charge an additional \$25 convenience fee.

No Daycamp on Saturdays or Sundays, Daycamp subject to availability, may be closed during holidays or School Break weeks

Doggie Day Camp: 1 or 2 visit per week- \$30 each day
 3 or more visits per week - \$25 each day
 2 dogs (in the same household) - \$5 off per dog
 * Dogs 80lbs + are \$30 per day, no multi day discount

Medications can be administered to your dog at a charge of \$1.00 per dosage.

**Camp Bark does offer Bus Services, depending on availability, is available for overnight campers by appointment only for a charge of \$35 each way. There is no bus service offered on Sundays or Holidays.

CAMP BARK WAIVER

_____ 1. I recognize that there are inherent risks of illness or injury when dealing with animals. Such risks include, but are not limited to, problems resulting from rough play, food scraps found outdoors, kennel cough (doggie colds), hot spots, and allergies.

_____ 2. I understand and agree that Camp Bark, LLC will not be liable for problems, damage, or injury caused by my dog provided reasonable care and precautions are followed by day care staff. I understand that Camp Bark, LLC is fully insured. I release Camp Bark, LLC of any liability arising from my dog's attendance and participation at the daycare. I understand that the day care is a place where animals co-mingle in groups. I understand that when dogs play in group's nicks and scratches may occur. Staff may or may not notify me immediately. If the injury is not serious staff may feel it is ok to leave the dog till the end of the day and let me know about it when I pick up. If the injury is serious, I will be notified immediately.

_____ 3. I understand and agree that any problem or injury that develops with my dog will be treated as deemed best by Camp Bark, LLC. Either my veterinarian or our veterinarian will be contacted in the event of a medical problem that is serious in nature.

_____ 4. I understand that I am responsible for any harm caused by my dog while my dog is attending Camp Bark. I shall indemnify Camp Bark, LLC against any claims made against the corporation or losses or damages of any kind suffered by Camp Bark as a result of my failure to inform Camp Bark of any pre-existing condition the dog may have (such as illness or aggression problems.) I understand and agree that in admitting my dog to Camp Bark the facility has relied on my representation that my dog is in good health and has not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog.

_____ 5. I, as the owner, agree to be solely responsible for any and all acts or behavior or my pet while in the care of Camp Bark, LLC. If my pet should become ill or seem to be in need of medical consideration, Camp Bark reserves the right to administer aid and/or to use any available veterinarian. I, the owner, shall pay any expenses so incurred.

_____ 6. I, as the owner, agree to pay our balance in full at time of pick up. ***Please note, Camp Bark does not accept Credit Cards nor Debit Cards. We only accept cash or personal check as form of payment.***
